Reporting to the Head of ICT, the IT Business Systems Manager will be responsible for managing, planning, directing, coordinating, monitoring, and supervising business and program processes and operation systems to ensure the efficiency of business and related systems. He/she will also ensure that operational, procedural and regulatory requirements are met.

### **Key Responsibilities**

- Deliver IT solutions that provide competitive advantage to support the growth of the business in a way that satisfies our clients' needs.
- Pro-actively contribute to the continuous improvement of technology/business processes through identifying opportunities for improvement and implementing changes.
- Oversee the system integration into the core banking system and day to day operational running of integrated channels.
- Take responsibility for the Bank's core banking systems, including administration, maintenance and development and other banking applications required in business operations
- Prepare, deploy and maintain various Intellect environments.
- Analyze CBS problems and implement innovative fixes, monitoring, tuning and performance optimization.
- Conduct market research to outline new system solutions that will improve current and future business capability.
- Participate in the formulation and development of the Bank IT strategy.
